

# DIVING: RECREATIONAL



Truk Lagoon is a wreck diver's paradise. 60% of the 60 wrecks in Truk Lagoon are 40m/130ft or shallower, putting them well within range of the experienced recreational diver.

We will have dedicated recreational diver boats, max. 6 people to a boat, and one boat per wreck, so there is no waiting for the Techies to surface and no one's dive will be cut short by another diver's gas consumption!

The wrecks themselves are teeming with color and life, so even if you're not keen on exploring the interiors of these wrecks, there is still plenty to see and enjoy.

The package includes 22 dives. You can choose to spread them out throughout the days, or do as many as possible upfront and purchase extra dives to maximise your dive count.

When you sign up for this trip, we will send you a huge digital packet with complete histories on Truk and the wrecks in the lagoon to enhance your experience.







# DIVING: TECHNICAL



Truk Lagoon is of course famous for it's world class deep wreck diving. Whether you want to do a 4-hour run time, or explore some of the deeper, less-dived wrecks, want to be guided or left to your own devices, we have partnered with legendary CCR and Technical Diving Instructor-Trainer Pete Mesley for logistics, so you can dive Truk Lagoon your way!

Most technical divers visiting Truk choose to do a deeper first dive and a shallower second dive, with a four hour surface interval inbetween, per day. Your package includes 22 dives, with a max of 6 divers per boat and one boat per site.

Whichever configuration you choose to dive, you will be supported! If you have questions regarding consumables (sorb, mix, 3L bottle rentals...) we are here to help, just reach out.







### THE HISTORY





Some of the bloodiest battles of WWII were fought in Micronesia. On February 17th and 18th 1944, the US navy launched a devastating air attack on the Japanese Imperial Fleet situated inside the sheltered waters of Truk Lagoon. The assault was fifteen times more powerful than the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbour. Code-named "Operation Hailstone" the initial strike was made up of 72 fighters launched from five carriers.



When the smoke cleared, 15 Japanese naval ships, 6 tankers, 17 cargo ships, 25 American planes and 250 Japanese planes were lying on the bottom of the Lagoon. Subsequent air raids in April, May and June sunk more ships, and by the end of the war more than 60 destroyed vessels were on the Lagoon bed.

Before WWII, Micronesia was an important colony for imperial Japan. The Pearl Harbor attacks were planned from Truk. The loss of Truk Lagoon during Operation Hailstone represented the beginning of the end for the Japanese war effort, 18 months before the bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.

## ACCOMMODATION



We will be staying at the Blue Lagoon Resort. The recently refurbished resort is positioned amongst 14 acres of gardens shaded by palm trees. 54 rooms, each with private bathrooms, TV, balcony or veranda are built in 2-story, low impact blocks, set along a white sandy beach with views out across historic Truk Lagoon.

There is also free internet access from the reception and restaurant areas. The resort has a back up generator for the times when the town power goes out so no worries with charging batteries for cameras, torches etc.

Apart from diving, the resort offers sea kayak rentals, fishing & boat excursions, a restaurant and choice of inside & outside bar land tours of Weno. A gift shop caters for those everyday items you may have left at home!

The restaurant offers the largest choice of western, local & Asian cuisine in truk, seafood being, of course, a specialty. You will be pleasantly surprised at the menu! No meals or beverages are included in this trip. All meals are taken in the resort restaurant and charged to the room to be settled at the end of our stay.








### THE ROUTES





The gateway to Truk (Chuuk) is Guam. Guam has international connections via Taiwan, Seoul, Tokyo and Honolulu.

You should plan to arrive into Guam on Oct 31st and allow yourself an overnight before catching the flight to Truk on Nov 1st.

The non-stop flight from Guam to Truk is 1hr 50min.

### SAFETY

Truk Lagoon definitely qualifies as a remote location! We take safety incredibly seriously.

Firstly, we will have a Hyperbaric Doctor with us who is trained in field medicine and dive accident management. In addition, we will have an extensive medical kit.

All divers are required to dive within the limits of their certifications and all divers are required to carry dive accident insurance.

If a diver is unsafe in their diving practices jeopardizing the safety of themselves and their fellow divers, we reserve the right to cease all diving activities of that person.

All divers, recreational and technical alike, are responsible for planning their own dives and diving conservatively.




### **EXCLUSIONS**

- Flights
- Exit tax (USD\$30 to be paid in cash upon leaving Truk.)
- Any required visas for travel to and within Micronesia
- Meals, Soft drinks and alcoholic beverages
- Dive equipment other than cylinders and weights
- Travel and Dive Insurance (proof of dive accident insurance required.)
- Consumables: Nitrox, O2, Helium, Sorb (prices available upon request.)
- Personal expenses
- Additional boat dive packages may be purchased if 22 dives is not enough!

#### **Payment**

To guarantee your space on the trip, 50% deposit is due with the registration form. When we receive your payment and completed booking form, you will receive our detailed trip information booklet that has a ton more information to prepare for the experience and destination.

Balance of payment is due 1st January, 2024.
